UNDERSTANDING THE SCOPE: KEY PERIODS COVERED IN AN 11TH GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOK

AN 11TH GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOK WILL LIKELY EXPLORE THE RAPID INDUSTRIALIZATION, THE RISE OF BIG BUSINESS AND MONOPOLIES, MASSIVE IMMIGRATION, AND THE GROWTH OF CITIES. THE PROGRESSIVE ERA, IN CONTRAST, IS CHARACTERIZED BY SOCIAL ACTIVISM AND POLITICAL REFORM AIMED AT ADDRESSING THE PROBLEMS CREATED BY INDUSTRIALIZATION AND URBANIZATION. THIS INCLUDES THE FIGHT FOR WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE, LABOR

RIGHTS, AND CONSUMER PROTECTION.

WORLD WARS AND THE INTERWAR PERIOD

THE 20TH CENTURY'S GLOBAL CONFLICTS ARE A SIGNIFICANT FOCUS. THE 11TH GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOK WILL DEDICATE SUBSTANTIAL CONTENT TO WORLD WAR I, THE CAUSES AND CONSEQUENCES OF AMERICAN INVOLVEMENT, AND THE IMPACT ON DOMESTIC SOCIETY. THE INTERWAR PERIOD, MARKED BY THE ROARING TWENTIES AND THE GREAT DEPRESSION, SETS THE STAGE FOR WORLD WAR II. THE TEXTBOOK WILL DETAIL THE ECONOMIC DEVASTATION OF THE DEPRESSION, THE NEW DEAL POLICIES OF FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT, AND THE GLOBAL POLITICAL TENSIONS THAT LED TO THE SECOND WORLD WAR.

WORLD WAR II AND THE COLD WAR

WORLD WAR II IS A CRITICAL CHAPTER, COVERING THE EVENTS FROM PEARL HARBOR TO THE ALLIED VICTORY. AN 11TH GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOK WILL ANALYZE THE WAR'S IMPACT ON THE HOME FRONT, THE HOLOCAUST, AND THE DAWN OF THE ATOMIC AGE. THE STRUGGLE FOR CIVIL RIGHTS FOR AFRICAN AMERICANS IS A DEEPLY IMPORTANT THEME. ACCESSIBILITY FEATURES

CONNECTING PAST TO PRESENT

ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT ROLES OF AN 11TH GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOK IS TO HELP STUDENTS UNDERSTAND THE RELEVANCE OF HISTORICAL EVENTS TO THEIR OWN LIVES AND TO CONTEMPORARY SOCIETY. COLLABORATIVE LEARNING STRATEGIES

GROUP WORK AND COLLABORATIVE ACTIVITIES CAN ENHANCE LEARNING BY EXPOSING STUDENTS TO DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES AND FOSTERING PEER-TO-PEER TEACHING. USING THE 11TH GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOK, STUDENTS CAN WORK TOGETHER ON ANALYZING DOCUMENTS, COMPLETING RESEARCH PROJECTS, OR PREPARING PRESENTATIONS. AS YOU STUDY, CONSCIOUSLY TRY TO IDENTIFY THESE LINKS. FOR EXAMPLE, HOW DID THE ECONOMIC POLICIES OF THE GILDED AGE INFLUENCE THE SOCIAL REFORMS OF THE PROGRESSIVE ERA? OR HOW DO THE DEBATES OVER STATES' RIGHTS IN THE 19TH CENTURY ECHO IN CONTEMPORARY POLITICAL DISCOURSE?

THE EVOLVING LANDSCAPE OF 11TH GRADE AMERICAN HISTORY

THIS INCLUDES SKILLS LIKE CHRONOLOGICAL REASONING, COMPARISON, CAUSATION, CONTINUITY AND CHANGE OVER TIME, AND CONTEXTUALIZATION. AN UPDATED 11TH GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOK WILL LIKELY BE DESIGNED WITH ACTIVITIES THAT EXPLICITLY FOSTER THESE ABILITIES.

DIGITAL INTEGRATION AND NEW MEDIA

DOCUMENTARIES AND HISTORICAL FILMS

MUSEUMS AND HISTORICAL SITES

THE TEXT MAY ALSO PRESENT MULTIPLE INTERPRETATIONS OF EVENTS TO FOSTER CRITICAL THINKING ABOUT HOW HISTORY IS CONSTRUCTED.

ARE THERE ANY SIGNIFICANT UPDATES OR NEW PERSPECTIVES INTRODUCED IN RECENT EDITIONS OF 11TH-GRADE HISTORY TEXTBOOKS?
