

4 PILLARS OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

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THE 4 PILLARS OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH OFFER A COMPREHENSIVE AND STRUCTURED FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING AND LIVING THE CATHOLIC FAITH. THESE FOUNDATIONAL ELEMENTS, OFTEN REFERRED TO AS THE "FOUR GREAT PILLARS," SERVE AS A ROADMAP FOR BELIEVERS, GUIDING THEM THROUGH THE CORE TENETS OF THEIR SPIRITUAL JOURNEY. THIS ARTICLE DELVES DEEPLY INTO EACH OF THESE PILLARS: THE PROFESSION OF FAITH (CREED), THE SACRAMENTS (WORSHIP AND LITURGY), LIFE IN CHRIST (MORALITY), AND PRAYER. BY EXPLORING THESE ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS, WE AIM TO PROVIDE A CLEAR AND INSIGHTFUL UNDERSTANDING OF THE CHURCH'S TEACHINGS, THEIR SIGNIFICANCE IN DAILY LIFE, AND HOW THEY ILLUMINATE THE PATH TO SALVATION. WHETHER YOU ARE A LIFELONG CATHOLIC SEEKING TO DEEPEN YOUR KNOWLEDGE OR SOMEONE CURIOUS ABOUT THE ESSENCE OF CATHOLICISM, THIS EXPLORATION WILL OFFER VALUABLE INSIGHTS INTO THE ENDURING WISDOM OF THE CATECHISM.

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THE FIRST PILLAR: THE PROFESSION OF FAITH – THE CREED

THE FIRST PILLAR OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IS THE PROFESSION OF FAITH, MOST COMMONLY EXPRESSED THROUGH THE NICENE AND APOSTLES' CREEDS. THESE CREEDS ARE NOT MERE HISTORICAL DOCUMENTS BUT LIVING ARTICULATIONS OF WHAT CATHOLICS BELIEVE ABOUT GOD AND HIS PLAN FOR HUMANITY. THEY SERVE AS THE BEDROCK UPON WHICH ALL OTHER ASPECTS OF FAITH ARE BUILT, OUTLINING THE FUNDAMENTAL TRUTHS OF THE CHRISTIAN MESSAGE. UNDERSTANDING THE CREED IS ESSENTIAL FOR COMPREHENDING THE ENTIRETY OF CATHOLIC DOCTRINE.

GOD, THE FATHER ALMIGHTY

AT THE HEART OF THE PROFESSION OF FAITH LIES THE BELIEF IN ONE GOD, WHO IS FATHER, ALMIGHTY, CREATOR OF HEAVEN AND EARTH. THIS BELIEF IN GOD'S OMNIPOTENCE AND CREATIVE POWER IS THE STARTING POINT OF ALL REVELATION. IT SPEAKS TO A GOD WHO IS NOT DISTANT OR INDIFFERENT BUT ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN HIS CREATION AND DEEPLY PERSONAL IN HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH US. THE CATECHISM EMPHASIZES THAT GOD'S FATHERHOOD IS THE SOURCE OF ALL LOVE AND THE ULTIMATE ORIGIN OF ALL THAT EXISTS. HIS ALMIGHTINESS SIGNIFIES HIS POWER OVER ALL THINGS, INCLUDING THE ABILITY TO OVERCOME EVIL AND DEATH, OFFERING HOPE AND ASSURANCE TO BELIEVERS.

JESUS CHRIST, HIS ONLY SON, OUR LORD

THE SECOND GREAT ARTICLE OF THE CREED FOCUSES ON JESUS CHRIST, THE ETERNAL SON OF GOD MADE MAN. THIS SECTION DETAILS HIS DIVINITY, HIS VIRGINAL CONCEPTION, HIS SUFFERING, DEATH, AND RESURRECTION, AND HIS ASCENSION INTO HEAVEN. THE INCARNATION – GOD BECOMING MAN IN THE PERSON OF JESUS – IS A CENTRAL MYSTERY OF THE CATHOLIC FAITH, DEMONSTRATING GOD'S IMMENSE LOVE AND DESIRE FOR COMMUNION WITH HUMANITY. HIS ATONING SACRIFICE ON THE CROSS AND HIS VICTORY OVER DEATH THROUGH THE RESURRECTION ARE THE VERY FOUNDATION OF CHRISTIAN HOPE AND SALVATION. THE TITLE "OUR LORD" SIGNIFIES HIS DIVINE AUTHORITY AND OUR SUBMISSION TO HIS WILL.

THE HOLY SPIRIT

THE THIRD ARTICLE OF THE CREED PROFESSES FAITH IN THE HOLY SPIRIT, THE THIRD PERSON OF THE BLESSED TRINITY. THE HOLY SPIRIT IS PRESENTED AS THE SANCTIFIER, WHO PROCEEDS FROM THE FATHER AND THE SON, AND WHO IS WORSHIPPED AND GLORIFIED WITH THEM. THE CATECHISM EXPLAINS THAT THE HOLY SPIRIT IS ACTIVELY PRESENT IN THE CHURCH, GUIDING HER, INSPIRING THE SCRIPTURES, AND EMPOWERING BELIEVERS IN THEIR SPIRITUAL LIVES. THE SPIRIT'S WORK IS SEEN IN THE SACRAMENTS, IN THE CHARISMS GIVEN TO THE FAITHFUL, AND IN THE INNER TRANSFORMATION OF INDIVIDUALS, LEADING THEM TO HOLINESS AND A DEEPER RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD.

THE SECOND PILLAR: THE SACRAMENTS – WORSHIP AND LITURGY

THE SECOND PILLAR OF THE CATECHISM IS THE SACRAMENTS, WHICH ARE THE VISIBLE SIGNS OF GOD'S INVISIBLE GRACE, INSTITUTED BY CHRIST AND ENTRUSTED TO THE CHURCH. THESE SACRED RITES ARE THE PRIMARY MEANS THROUGH WHICH CATHOLICS ENCOUNTER GOD AND RECEIVE HIS DIVINE LIFE. THEY ARE NOT MERELY SYMBOLIC ACTIONS BUT EFFICACIOUS SIGNS THAT TRULY CONFER THE GRACE THEY SIGNIFY. THIS PILLAR EXPLORES THE SEVEN SACRAMENTS AND THEIR PROFOUND ROLE IN THE CHRISTIAN LIFE, FROM BIRTH TO COMPLETION.

THE SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

THE SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION – BAPTISM, CONFIRMATION, AND THE EUCHARIST – ARE THE FOUNDATION OF CHRISTIAN LIFE. BAPTISM INCORPORATES INDIVIDUALS INTO CHRIST AND THE CHURCH, CLEANSING THEM FROM ORIGINAL SIN AND MAKING THEM

CHILDREN OF GOD. CONFIRMATION STRENGTHENS THE BAPTIZED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT, ENABLING THEM TO BEAR WITNESS TO CHRIST. THE EUCHARIST, THE "SOURCE AND SUMMIT" OF THE CHRISTIAN LIFE, NOURISHES BELIEVERS WITH THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST, UNITING THEM MORE DEEPLY WITH HIM AND WITH ONE ANOTHER. THESE SACRAMENTS MARK THE ENTRY INTO THE CHURCH AND THE ONGOING JOURNEY OF FAITH.

THE SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

THE SACRAMENTS OF HEALING, NAMELY PENANCE (RECONCILIATION) AND ANOINTING OF THE SICK, ARE ESSENTIAL FOR SPIRITUAL AND PHYSICAL WELL-BEING. THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE OFFERS FORGIVENESS FOR SINS COMMITTED AFTER BAPTISM, RESTORING THE RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD AND THE CHURCH THAT HAS BEEN BROKEN BY SIN. THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK PROVIDES SPIRITUAL STRENGTH, COURAGE, AND UNION WITH CHRIST'S SUFFERING FOR THOSE WHO ARE SERIOUSLY ILL OR IN DANGER OF DEATH, AND CAN ALSO BESTOW PHYSICAL HEALING IF IT IS GOD'S WILL. THESE SACRAMENTS HIGHLIGHT GOD'S BOUNDLESS MERCY AND HIS DESIRE TO HEAL AND RESTORE US.

THE SACRAMENTS AT THE SERVICE OF COMMUNION

THE SACRAMENTS AT THE SERVICE OF COMMUNION – HOLY ORDERS AND MATRIMONY – ARE DIRECTED TOWARD THE SALVATION OF OTHERS. HOLY ORDERS CONFERS A SACRED POWER FOR THE SERVICE OF THE CHURCH, ENABLING BISHOPS, PRIESTS, AND DEACONS TO MINISTER TO THE FAITHFUL. MATRIMONY ESTABLISHES A LIFELONG COVENANT OF LOVE BETWEEN A MAN AND A WOMAN, INTENDED FOR THE GOOD OF THE SPOUSES AND THE PROCREATION AND EDUCATION OF CHILDREN. THESE SACRAMENTS ARE VITAL FOR THE CONTINUATION AND GROWTH OF THE CHURCH AND THE SANCTIFICATION OF ITS MEMBERS WITHIN SPECIFIC VOCATIONS.

THE THIRD PILLAR: LIFE IN CHRIST – THE TEN COMMANDMENTS AND THE MORAL LIFE

THE THIRD PILLAR OF THE CATECHISM FOCUSES ON LIFE IN CHRIST, WHICH ENCOMPASSES CHRISTIAN MORALITY, ETHICAL TEACHINGS, AND THE PATH TO LIVING A VIRTUOUS LIFE. THIS SECTION DELVES INTO THE DIVINE LAW, PARTICULARLY THE TEN COMMANDMENTS, AND HOW THEY GUIDE BELIEVERS IN THEIR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD AND WITH THEIR NEIGHBOR. IT ALSO ADDRESSES THE NATURE OF SIN AND THE IMPORTANCE OF GOD'S GRACE IN LIVING A LIFE PLEASING TO HIM. THIS PILLAR IS ABOUT THE PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF FAITH IN DAILY ACTIONS AND CHOICES.

THE GREAT COMMANDMENT: LOVE OF GOD AND NEIGHBOR

AT THE CORE OF CHRISTIAN MORALITY, AS PRESENTED IN THE CATECHISM, IS THE GREAT COMMANDMENT: TO LOVE GOD WITH ALL ONE'S HEART, SOUL, AND MIND, AND TO LOVE ONE'S NEIGHBOR AS ONESELF. JESUS HIMSELF IDENTIFIED THESE TWO COMMANDMENTS AS THE GREATEST. THEY ARE NOT SEPARATE BUT INTRINSICALLY LINKED; ONE CANNOT TRULY LOVE GOD WITHOUT LOVING ONE'S NEIGHBOR, AND AUTHENTIC LOVE FOR NEIGHBOR FLOWS FROM THE LOVE OF GOD. THE TEN COMMANDMENTS SERVE AS A PRACTICAL EXPRESSION OF THIS TWOFOLD LOVE, OUTLINING OUR DUTIES TOWARDS GOD AND OUR RESPONSIBILITIES TOWARD ONE ANOTHER.

LIVING THE MORAL LIFE

LIVING THE MORAL LIFE, AS GUIDED BY THE CATECHISM, INVOLVES STRIVING FOR HOLINESS THROUGH THE PRACTICE OF VIRTUES AND THE AVOIDANCE OF SIN. THIS INCLUDES UNDERSTANDING THE TEACHINGS ON CONSCIENCE, MORAL DECISION-MAKING, AND THE PURSUIT OF GOOD. THE CATECHISM EXPLORES VIRTUES SUCH AS FAITH, HOPE, CHARITY, PRUDENCE, JUSTICE, TEMPERANCE, AND FORTITUDE, EXPLAINING HOW THEY ARE DEVELOPED THROUGH PRACTICE AND GOD'S GRACE. IT ALSO ADDRESSES SPECIFIC MORAL ISSUES, PROVIDING CLEAR GUIDANCE ON HOW TO LIVE AS DISCIPLES OF CHRIST IN THE WORLD.

SIN AND GOD'S MERCY

THIS ASPECT OF THE THIRD PILLAR ADDRESSES THE REALITY OF SIN AND ITS CONSEQUENCES, AS WELL AS THE IMMENSE AND UNWAVERING MERCY OF GOD. SIN IS UNDERSTOOD AS AN OFFENSE AGAINST GOD, A RUPTURE IN OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM, AND A WOUND TO OURSELVES AND OTHERS. THE CATECHISM EXPLAINS DIFFERENT TYPES OF SIN, INCLUDING MORTAL AND VENIAL SIN, AND THEIR IMPACT. CRUCIALLY, IT EMPHASIZES THAT GOD'S MERCY IS ALWAYS AVAILABLE, ESPECIALLY THROUGH THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION, OFFERING THE OPPORTUNITY FOR FORGIVENESS, HEALING, AND RESTORATION TO GRACE.

THE FOURTH PILLAR: PRAYER – THE LIFE OF PRAYER

THE FOURTH PILLAR OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IS PRAYER, WHICH IS THE LIVING RELATIONSHIP OF THE CHILD OF GOD WITH THE FATHER, THROUGH CHRIST, IN THE HOLY SPIRIT. PRAYER IS NOT AN OPTIONAL EXTRA BUT AN ESSENTIAL ELEMENT OF THE CHRISTIAN LIFE, A VITAL MEANS OF COMMUNION WITH GOD. THIS PILLAR EXPLORES THE DIFFERENT FORMS AND DIMENSIONS OF PRAYER, ITS IMPORTANCE IN THE LIFE OF FAITH, AND HOW BELIEVERS CAN CULTIVATE A DEEP AND CONSISTENT PRAYER LIFE.

THE OUR FATHER: THE LORD'S PRAYER

THE OUR FATHER, OR THE LORD'S PRAYER, IS PRESENTED AS THE "SUMMARY OF THE WHOLE GOSPEL" AND THE MODEL FOR ALL CHRISTIAN PRAYER. JESUS HIMSELF TAUGHT THIS PRAYER TO HIS DISCIPLES. THE CATECHISM METICULOUSLY UNPACKS EACH PETITION OF THE OUR FATHER, REVEALING ITS PROFOUND THEOLOGICAL AND SPIRITUAL MEANING. IT GUIDES BELIEVERS IN ASKING FOR GOD'S GLORY, HIS KINGDOM, AND HIS WILL TO BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN, AS WELL AS FOR DAILY SUSTENANCE, FORGIVENESS, PROTECTION FROM TEMPTATION, AND DELIVERANCE FROM EVIL. IT IS A BLUEPRINT FOR APPROACHING GOD WITH TRUST AND SINCERITY.

THE BATTLE OF PRAYER

THE CATECHISM ACKNOWLEDGES THAT PRAYER IS NOT ALWAYS EASY; IT CAN BE A SPIRITUAL BATTLE. THIS SECTION ADDRESSES THE CHALLENGES BELIEVERS MAY FACE, SUCH AS DISTRACTION, DRYNESS, DOUBT, AND TEMPTATIONS TO ABANDON PRAYER. IT ENCOURAGES PERSEVERANCE AND FAITHFULNESS, HIGHLIGHTING THAT EVEN IN TIMES OF DIFFICULTY, GOD REMAINS PRESENT AND RESPONSIVE TO SINCERE PRAYER. THE UNDERSTANDING OF PRAYER AS A STRUGGLE UNDERSCORES THE ACTIVE PARTICIPATION REQUIRED AND THE IMPORTANCE OF RELYING ON GOD'S STRENGTH, RATHER THAN OUR OWN.

THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS AND PRAYER

THE CONCEPT OF THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS, WHICH IS PART OF THE PROFESSION OF FAITH, ALSO PLAYS A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN THE PILLAR OF PRAYER. CATHOLICS BELIEVE THAT THOSE IN HEAVEN, PARTICULARLY THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY AND THE SAINTS, CAN INTERCEDE FOR THOSE ON EARTH. THIS MEANS THAT PRAYER IS NOT SOLELY A SOLITARY ACT BUT ALSO A COMMUNAL ONE, WHERE BELIEVERS CAN ASK FOR THE PRAYERS OF THOSE WHO ARE ALREADY WITH GOD. THIS UNDERSTANDING FOSTERS A SENSE OF SOLIDARITY WITHIN THE CHURCH, BOTH ON EARTH AND IN HEAVEN, AND ENRICHES THE PRACTICE OF PRAYER.

THE INTERCONNECTEDNESS OF THE FOUR PILLARS

IT IS CRUCIAL TO UNDERSTAND THAT THE 4 PILLARS OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH ARE NOT ISOLATED DOCTRINES BUT ARE DEEPLY INTERCONNECTED AND MUTUALLY REINFORCING. THE PROFESSION OF FAITH (CREED) PROVIDES THE ESSENTIAL CONTENT OF WHAT CATHOLICS BELIEVE, FORMING THE INTELLECTUAL FOUNDATION. THE SACRAMENTS (WORSHIP AND LITURGY) ARE THE CHANNELS THROUGH WHICH GOD'S GRACE, MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH CHRIST, IS IMPARTED AND EXPERIENCED, MAKING FAITH TANGIBLE. LIFE IN CHRIST (MORALITY) IS THE LIVED EXPRESSION OF THAT FAITH, GUIDED BY DIVINE LAW AND EMPOWERED BY GRACE. FINALLY, PRAYER IS THE VITAL RELATIONSHIP THAT SUSTAINS AND NOURISHES THE BELIEVER'S

JOURNEY THROUGH ALL THESE ASPECTS, FOSTERING A PERSONAL ENCOUNTER WITH GOD.

ONE CANNOT TRULY UNDERSTAND OR LIVE THE SACRAMENTS WITHOUT BELIEVING IN THE TRUTHS OF THE CREED. SIMILARLY, LIVING A MORAL LIFE IS AN AUTHENTIC RESPONSE TO THE GRACES RECEIVED THROUGH THE SACRAMENTS AND A LIVED OUT EXPRESSION OF ONE'S FAITH. PRAYER IS THE OXYGEN THAT ANIMATES ALL THREE, ENABLING GROWTH IN FAITH, RECEPTION OF SACRAMENTS, AND FIDELITY TO THE MORAL LIFE. THE CATECHISM PRESENTS THESE PILLARS AS A UNIFIED WHOLE, A GUIDE FOR A COMPLETE AND FULFILLING SPIRITUAL LIFE, LEADING THE FAITHFUL TOWARD A DEEPER RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD AND ULTIMATELY, TO ETERNAL LIFE.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT ARE THE 'FOUR PILLARS' OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH, AND WHY ARE THEY SIGNIFICANT?

THE FOUR PILLARS ARE THE MAIN SECTIONS OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH, PROVIDING A COMPREHENSIVE OVERVIEW OF CATHOLIC FAITH AND PRACTICE. THEY ARE: 1. THE CREED (FAITH), 2. THE SACRAMENTS (WORSHIP AND LITURGY), 3. THE COMMANDMENTS AND THE SACRAMENTAL LIFE (CHRISTIAN LIFE), AND 4. PRAYER (SPIRITUAL LIFE). THEY ARE SIGNIFICANT BECAUSE THEY STRUCTURE THE CHURCH'S TEACHINGS, MAKING THEM ACCESSIBLE AND UNDERSTANDABLE FOR BOTH CLERGY AND LAITY.

HOW DOES THE 'CREED' PILLAR RELATE TO THE CORE BELIEFS OF CATHOLICISM, AND WHAT ARE SOME KEY TAKEAWAYS?

THE CREED PILLAR OUTLINES THE FUNDAMENTAL BELIEFS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH, CENTERED ON THE APOSTLES' CREED AND THE NICENE CREED. IT EXPLAINS THE NATURE OF GOD (FATHER, SON, HOLY SPIRIT), THE ROLE OF JESUS CHRIST, THE CHURCH, AND THE RESURRECTION OF THE DEAD. KEY TAKEAWAYS INCLUDE THE TRIUNE GOD, THE INCARNATION AND SALVIFIC WORK OF CHRIST, AND THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS.

IN THE 'SACRAMENTS' PILLAR, WHAT IS THE CHURCH'S TEACHING ON THE SEVEN SACRAMENTS, AND WHY ARE THEY CALLED 'MEANS OF GRACE'?

THE SACRAMENTS PILLAR DETAILS THE SEVEN SACRAMENTS (BAPTISM, CONFIRMATION, EUCHARIST, PENANCE, ANOINTING OF THE SICK, HOLY ORDERS, AND MATRIMONY) AS VISIBLE SIGNS INSTITUTED BY CHRIST TO GIVE GRACE. THEY ARE CALLED 'MEANS OF GRACE' BECAUSE THEY ARE OUTWARD SIGNS THAT CONVEY GOD'S INVISIBLE SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS AND EFFECTS, ENABLING BELIEVERS TO PARTICIPATE IN DIVINE LIFE AND GROW IN HOLINESS.

WHAT DOES THE 'COMMANDMENTS AND SACRAMENTAL LIFE' PILLAR TEACH ABOUT LIVING A CHRISTIAN LIFE, AND HOW DO THE TEN COMMANDMENTS FIT IN?

THIS PILLAR CONNECTS THE MORAL TEACHINGS OF CHRISTIANITY WITH THE GRACE RECEIVED THROUGH THE SACRAMENTS. IT EMPHASIZES THAT LIVING A CHRISTIAN LIFE INVOLVES RESPONDING TO GOD'S LOVE BY ADHERING TO HIS COMMANDMENTS, PARTICULARLY THE TEN COMMANDMENTS, AND LIVING OUT THE VIRTUES. THE COMMANDMENTS SERVE AS A GUIDE FOR RIGHTEOUS LIVING, WHILE THE SACRAMENTS PROVIDE THE SUPERNATURAL STRENGTH NEEDED TO FULFILL THEM.

HOW IS PRAYER EXPLAINED AND ENCOURAGED IN THE 'PRAYER' PILLAR, AND WHAT ARE THE MAIN FORMS OF CATHOLIC PRAYER?

THE PRAYER PILLAR EXPLORES THE CHURCH'S TEACHING ON PRAYER AS A RESPONSE OF FAITH TO GOD'S INITIATIVE. IT HIGHLIGHTS PRAYER AS A VITAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD, OFFERING GUIDANCE ON VARIOUS FORMS, INCLUDING VOCAL PRAYER, MEDITATION, AND CONTEMPLATIVE PRAYER. THE LORD'S PRAYER IS PRESENTED AS THE QUINTESSENTIAL PRAYER, EMBODYING THE CORE OF CHRISTIAN SUPPLICATION.

WHY IS THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH CONSIDERED A 'RELIABLE REFERENCE WORK' FOR THE FAITHFUL?

THE CATECHISM IS CONSIDERED A RELIABLE REFERENCE WORK BECAUSE IT SYNTHESIZES AND PRESENTS THE CHURCH'S AUTHENTIC TEACHINGS ON FAITH AND MORALS, DRAWING FROM SCRIPTURE, TRADITION, AND THE MAGISTERIUM. IT AIMS TO PROVIDE A CLEAR, COMPREHENSIVE, AND ACCESSIBLE GUIDE FOR UNDERSTANDING AND LIVING OUT THE CATHOLIC FAITH IN ITS ENTIRETY.

WHAT IS THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FAITH (CREED) AND ACTION (COMMANDMENTS) AS PRESENTED IN THE CATECHISM'S FOUR PILLARS?

THE CATECHISM PRESENTS FAITH AND ACTION AS INTRINSICALLY LINKED. THE CREED ARTICULATES WHAT CATHOLICS BELIEVE ABOUT GOD AND HIS PLAN, WHILE THE COMMANDMENTS AND SACRAMENTAL LIFE OUTLINE HOW BELIEVERS ARE CALLED TO RESPOND TO THAT FAITH THROUGH THEIR ACTIONS AND PARTICIPATION IN THE SACRAMENTAL LIFE. TRUE FAITH, AS TAUGHT IN THE CATECHISM, NATURALLY LEADS TO GOOD WORKS AND A LIFE LIVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOD'S WILL.
