THE ETHICAL IMPERATIVE IS TO USE RESEARCH TO ENHANCE PRACTICE IN A WAY THAT IS BOTH EFFECTIVE AND RESPECTFUL.

STRATEGIES FOR EFFECTIVE APPLICATION OF RESEARCH FINDINGS
