INCORPORATING PERSONAL INTERESTS

TO BOOST ENGAGEMENT, CONSIDER TAILORING VOCABULARY LISTS AND EXERCISES TO LEARNERS' PERSONAL INTERESTS. IF A LEARNER IS PASSIONATE ABOUT SPORTS, INCLUDE SPORTS-RELATED VOCABULARY. FOR SOMEONE INTERESTED IN ART, FOCUS ON ARTISTIC TERMS. THIS PERSONALIZATION MAKES THE LEARNING PROCESS MORE ENJOYABLE AND RELEVANT, INCREASING MOTIVATION AND THE LIKELIHOOD OF RETENTION.

PROVIDING SCAFFOLDING AND SUPPORT

FOR LEARNERS WHO NEED EXTRA SUPPORT, CONSIDER ADDING SCAFFOLDING ELEMENTS TO YOUR WORKSHEETS. THIS COULD INCLUDE PROVIDING A WORD BANK FOR FILL-IN-THE-BLANK EXERCISES, OFFERING PARTIALLY COMPLETED SENTENCES, OR BREAKING DOWN COMPLEX DEFINITIONS INTO SIMPLER PARTS.
