DRIVEN BY HIS BELIEF IN HIS OWN EXCEPTIONALISM AND HIS DESPERATE FINANCIAL SITUATION, RASKOLNIKOV DECIDES TO TEST HIS THEORY BY COMMITTING A MURDER. HE TARGETS ALYONA IVANOVNA, AN ELDERLY AND AVARICIOUS PAWNBROKER WHOM HE VIEWS AS A SOCIAL PARASITE, SOMEONE WHOSE REMOVAL WOULD BENEFIT SOCIETY MORE THAN HER CONTINUED EXISTENCE.
