THE NOVEL EXPLORES THE COMPLEX NATURE OF FAMILY, HIGHLIGHTING HOW A FAMILY'S PAST CAN PROFOUNDLY IMPACT THEIR PRESENT AND FUTURE, AND THE LENGTHS TO WHICH PARENTS WILL GO TO PROTECT THEIR CHILDREN, EVEN AT GREAT PERSONAL COST.
