Bufs and Debufs

Bufs are positive effects applied to allies, while debufs are negative effects applied to enemies. Both are critical to combat. Learning which bufs and debufs are most effective in different situations is a key part of strategy.

- **Golem Hunt:** Drops Attack, Critical Hit, and Unity sets. Golems are Fire element, weak to Ice heroes.
- **Giant's Keep:** Drops Defense, Critical Hit Chance, and Resistance sets. Giants are Earth element, weak to Fire heroes.
- **Secret Shop:** Drops Speed, Counter, and Effect sets. Secret Shops are Lightning element, weak to Fire heroes.

Your goal is to build a team capable of reliably clearing Hunt 9 and then progressing to Hunt 10 and beyond. Hunt 10 drops 5-star gear, while higher levels drop 6-star gear with better stats.

The Abyss

The Abyss is a tower-like dungeon with increasingly difficult floors, each offering unique rewards, including catalysts, currency, and powerful equipment. It's an excellent place to test your teams and acquire valuable resources.

Prioritize clearing as many Abyss floors as you can. The rewards are very generous and will significantly boost your early-to-mid game progression. Many Abyss floors also introduce specific mechanics that teach you about different debuffs, buffs, and team compositions.
