ADOLF HITLER

FAMOUS ARTISTS AND WRITERS KNOWN FOR NARCISSISTIC TRAITS

MANY RENOWNED ARTISTS AND WRITERS HAVE EXHIBITED NARCISSISTIC BEHAVIORS, OFTEN LINKED TO THEIR INTENSE SELF-FOCUS AND DESIRE FOR RECOGNITION. LORD BYRON

LORD BYRON, A LEADING FIGURE OF THE ROMANTIC MOVEMENT IN LITERATURE, EXHIBITED CLASSIC NARCISSISTIC BEHAVIORS SUCH AS SELF-CENTEREDNESS, CHARM, AND A FLAIR FOR DRAMATICS. ELON MUSK

- **SENSE OF ENTITLEMENT:** UNREASONABLE EXPECTATIONS OF FAVORABLE TREATMENT.
- **INTERPERSONALLY EXPLOITATIVE BEHAVIOR:** TAKING ADVANTAGE OF OTHERS TO ACHIEVE GOALS.
- **LACK OF EMPATHY:** INABILITY OR UNWILLINGNESS TO RECOGNIZE OTHERS' FEELINGS.
- **ENVY OF OTHERS OR BELIEF OTHERS ARE ENVIOUS:** COMPETITIVE AND RESENTFUL ATTITUDES.
- **ARROGANT AND HAUGHTY BEHAVIORS OR ATTITUDES:** PATRONIZING OR CONTEMPTUOUS DEMEANOR.

IMPACT ON HISTORY AND SOCIETY
