TEEN DRIVERS APPLYING FOR LEARNER'S PERMITS MUST ALSO PASS THIS EXAM. SOME EXCEPTIONS APPLY TO HOLDERS OF VALID DRIVER'S LICENSES FROM CERTAIN COUNTRIES OR RECIPROCAL AGREEMENTS.

ANSWER: AT LEAST 100 FEET IN ADVANCE.

5. **WHAT SHOULD YOU DO IF AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE WITH FLASHING LIGHTS APPROACHES?**

ANSWER: PULL OVER TO THE RIGHT EDGE OF THE ROAD AND STOP UNTIL IT PASSES.

COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE (CDL)

FOR THOSE OPERATING COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, FLORIDA REQUIRES A CDL, WHICH INVOLVES ADDITIONAL WRITTEN AND SKILLS TESTS SPECIFIC TO COMMERCIAL DRIVING. REQUIREMENTS VARY DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLE AND ENDORSEMENTS NEEDED.

RENEWAL AND TRANSFERS
