THE ROLE OF SUNLIGHT AND WATER IN PLANT GROWTH

SPREADING THE SEEDS

ONCE POLLINATION AND FERTILIZATION ARE COMPLETE, SEEDS BEGIN TO FORM. GIBBONS THEN DELVES INTO THE VARIOUS METHODS OF SEED DISPERSAL, EXPLAINING HOW SEEDS ARE SPREAD AWAY FROM THE PARENT PLANT. THIS CAN HAPPEN THROUGH SEVERAL MEANS: WIND BLOWING LIGHTWEIGHT SEEDS, ANIMALS EATING FRUITS AND THEN DEPOSITING SEEDS ELSEWHERE, OR SEEDS HAVING SPECIAL FEATURES LIKE HOOKS OR WINGS THAT HELP THEM ATTACH TO PASSING ANIMALS OR FLOAT ON WATER. EFFECTIVE DISPERSAL IS VITAL TO PREVENT OVERCROWDING AND TO COLONIZE NEW AREAS.

EDUCATIONAL VALUE OF "FROM SEED TO PLANT"

WHAT IS THE TYPICAL READING LEVEL FOR GAIL GIBBONS' 'FROM SEED TO PLANT'?

THIS BOOK IS GENERALLY AIMED AT EMERGENT READERS, TYPICALLY IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH THIRD GRADE, DUE TO ITS CLEAR LANGUAGE, ENGAGING ILLUSTRATIONS, AND STRAIGHTFORWARD EXPLANATION OF CONCEPTS.

BESIDES THE CORE LIFE CYCLE, WHAT OTHER RELATED PLANT CONCEPTS MIGHT A CHILD LEARN FROM THIS BOOK?

CHILDREN MIGHT ALSO LEARN ABOUT DIFFERENT TYPES OF SEEDS, HOW SEEDS ARE DISPERSED (SPREAD), THE FUNCTION OF DIFFERENT PLANT PARTS (ROOTS, STEMS, LEAVES, FLOWERS), AND THE IMPORTANCE OF PLANTS IN OUR ENVIRONMENT.
