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ORIGINS AND BACKGROUND OF GENE SHARP

GENE SHARP WAS A PIONEERING FIGURE IN POLITICAL SCIENCE, FOCUSING ON THE DYNAMICS OF NONVIOLENT ACTION AND CIVIL RESISTANCE.
