HISTORICAL FOUNDATIONS OF GERMANY

WORLD WAR II AND THE HOLOCAUST

WORLD WAR II REPRESENTS THE DARKEST CHAPTER IN GERMANY'S HISTORY, WITH THE RISE OF THE NAZI REGIME, CATASTROPHIC WARFARE, AND THE HOLOCAUST. THE MEMORY OF THIS PERIOD IS CENTRAL TO GERMANY'S NATIONAL IDENTITY, INVOLVING AN ONGOING PROCESS OF REMEMBRANCE, EDUCATION, AND RECONCILIATION. DIVISION AND REUNIFICATION

THE DIVISION OF GERMANY INTO EAST AND WEST FOLLOWING WORLD WAR II AND THE EVENTUAL REUNIFICATION IN 1990 ARE DEFINING MOMENTS IN THE NATION'S COLLECTIVE MEMORY. THESE EVENTS HIGHLIGHT THEMES OF IDEOLOGICAL CONFLICT, SEPARATION, AND ULTIMATELY, NATIONAL UNITY.

THE COLD WAR AND THE BERLIN WALL

THE COLD WAR ERA SAW GERMANY SPLIT INTO TWO STATES: THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY (WEST GERMANY) AND THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC (EAST GERMANY). REUNIFICATION AND NATIONAL HEALING

THE FALL OF THE BERLIN WALL IN 1989 AND THE SUBSEQUENT REUNIFICATION OF GERMANY IN 1990 MARKED A MOMENTOUS OCCASION IN NATIONAL MEMORY. IT SYMBOLIZED HOPE, RENEWAL, AND THE OVERCOMING OF DIVISION.
