- THE STUDENT WILL DEMONSTRATE PROFICIENCY IN ADDING, SUBTRACTING, MULTIPLYING, AND DIVIDING RATIONAL NUMBERS BY COMPLETING PRACTICE EXERCISES AT 90% ACCURACY.

- THE STUDENT WILL GRAPH LINEAR FUNCTIONS ON A COORDINATE PLANE WITH 80% ACCURACY DURING ASSESSMENTS.
