THE ORIGINS AND HISTORY OF ISLAM

THE EARLY HISTORY OF ISLAM IS MARKED BY THE REVELATION OF THE QURAN, MUHAMMAD'S LEADERSHIP, AND THE SUBSEQUENT EXPANSION OF THE ISLAMIC EMPIRE. THE LIFE OF PROPHET MUHAMMAD

HIS LIFE EXEMPLIFIES THE IDEAL MUSLIM CONDUCT AND SERVES AS A MODEL FOR FOLLOWERS WORLDWIDE.

EARLY ISLAMIC EXPANSION

FOLLOWING MUHAMMAD'S DEATH IN 632 CE, ISLAM RAPIDLY EXPANDED BEYOND ARABIA THROUGH MILITARY CONQUESTS, TRADE, AND MISSIONARY ACTIVITIES. THE RASHIDUN CALIPHATE, FOLLOWED BY THE Umayyad and Abbasid dynasties, PLAYED SIGNIFICANT ROLES IN SPREADING ISLAM ACROSS THE MIDDLE EAST, NORTH AFRICA, AND PARTS OF ASIA AND EUROPE.

THIS EXPANSION FACILITATED CULTURAL EXCHANGES AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF ISLAMIC CIVILIZATION, WHICH CONTRIBUTED TO ADVANCEMENTS IN SCIENCE, PHILOSOPHY, AND ART.

CORE BELIEFS AND THE FIVE PILLARS

ISLAM IS FOUNDED ON ESSENTIAL THEOLOGICAL AND PRACTICAL COMPONENTS THAT SHAPE THE FAITH AND DAILY LIFE OF MUSLIMS. CENTRAL TO ISLAMIC BELIEF IS THE CONCEPT OF TAWHID, THE ABSOLUTE ONENESS OF GOD. CORE BELIEFS (ARTICLES OF FAITH)

MUSLIMS ADHERE TO SIX PRIMARY BELIEFS, OFTEN REFERRED TO AS THE ARTICLES OF FAITH:

- **BELIEF IN ALLAH:** THE ONE AND ONLY GOD, CREATOR OF ALL.
- **BELIEF IN ANGELS:** SPIRITUAL BEINGS WHO CARRY OUT GOD'S COMMANDS.
- **BELIEF IN THE PROPHETS:** MESSENGERS SENT BY GOD, INCLUDING ADAM, MOSES, JESUS, AND MUHAMMAD.
- **BELIEF IN THE HOLY BOOKS:** SCRIPTURES REVEALED TO PROPHETS, NOTABLY THE QURAN.
- **BELIEF IN THE DAY OF JUDGMENT:** THE FINAL ASSESSMENT OF HUMAN DEEDS.
- **BELIEF IN PREDESTINATION:** DIVINE DECREE OVER ALL EVENTS.

THE FIVE PILLARS OF ISLAM

THE FIVE PILLARS PROVIDE THE PRACTICAL FRAMEWORK FOR MUSLIM LIFE AND WORSHIP. THEY INCLUDE:

1. **SHAHADA (FAITH):** THE DECLARATION OF FAITH STATING THERE IS NO GOD BUT ALLAH, AND MUHAMMAD IS HIS MESSENGER.
2. **SALAH (PRAYER):** PERFORMING FIVE DAILY PRAYERS FACING MECCA.
3. **ZAKAT (ALMSGIVING):** GIVING A PORTION OF WEALTH TO THE NEEDY.
4. **SAWM (FASTING):** ABSTAINING FROM FOOD, DRINK, AND OTHER PHYSICAL NEEDS DURING RAMADAN.
5. **HAJJ (PILGRIMAGE):** UNDERTAKING A PILGRIMAGE TO MECCA AT LEAST ONCE IF PHYSICALLY AND FINANCIALLY ABLE.

THE QURAN AND HADITH

THE QURAN IS THE CENTRAL RELIGIOUS TEXT OF ISLAM, BELIEVED TO BE THE LITERAL WORD OF GOD AS REVEALED TO MUHAMMAD. IT IS WRITTEN IN CLASSICAL ARABIC AND IS COMPOSED OF 114 CHAPTERS CALLED SURAHS. THE QURAN GUIDES ALL ASPECTS OF A MUSLIM'S FAITH AND PRACTICE, COVERING THEOLOGY, MORALITY, LAW, AND SPIRITUALITY. COMPLEMENTING THE QURAN ARE THE HADITH, COLLECTIONS OF SAYINGS, ACTIONS, AND APPROVALS OF PROPHET MUHAMMAD, WHICH HELP INTERPRET THE QURAN AND PROVIDE GUIDANCE ON DAILY LIFE.

THE QURAN: STRUCTURE AND SIGNIFICANCE

THE QURAN'S UNIQUE COMPOSITION INCLUDES LEGAL RULINGS, ETHICAL INSTRUCTIONS, NARRATIVES OF EARLIER PROPHETS, AND SPIRITUAL REFLECTIONS. MUSLIMS RECITE AND MEMORIZE VERSES AS ACTS OF WORSHIP, AND THE QURAN SERVES AS THE ULTIMATE SOURCE OF AUTHORITY IN ISLAMIC THEOLOGY AND JURISPRUDENCE. ITS PRESERVATION AND RECITATION HAVE BEEN CENTRAL TO ISLAMIC CULTURE AND IDENTITY THROUGHOUT HISTORY.

HADITH: GUIDANCE BEYOND THE QURAN

THE HADITH LITERATURE COMPLEMENTS THE QURAN BY OFFERING DETAILED GUIDANCE ON VARIOUS MATTERS NOT EXPLICITLY COVERED IN THE QURAN. THESE NARRATIONS PROVIDE CONTEXT FOR THE PROPHET'S LIFE AND TEACHINGS, IMPACTING ISLAMIC LAW AND ETHICS. AUTHENTICITY AND CLASSIFICATION OF HADITH ARE CRITICAL IN ISLAMIC SCHOLARSHIP, WITH MAJOR COLLECTIONS SUCH AS SAHIH AL-BUKHARI AND SAHIH MUSLIM CONSIDERED HIGHLY RELIABLE.

ISLAMIC PRACTICES AND WORSHIP

DAILY PRAYERS (SALAH)

SALAH IS PERFORMED FIVE TIMES DAILY: AT DAWN, NOON, MID-AFTERNOON, SUNSET, AND NIGHT. EACH PRAYER CONSISTS OF SPECIFIC PHYSICAL POSTURES AND RECITATIONS FROM THE QURAN. PRAYER SERVES AS A DIRECT LINK BETWEEN THE BELIEVER AND GOD, EMPHASIZING MINDFULNESS AND SUBMISSION.

FASTING DURING RAMADAN

RAMADAN IS THE NINTH MONTH OF THE ISLAMIC CALENDAR, OBSERVED BY FASTING FROM DAWN TO SUNSET. THIS FAST INVOLVES REFRAINING FROM FOOD, DRINK, SMOKING, AND MARITAL RELATIONS. FASTING PURIFIES THE SOUL, DEVELOPS SELF-CONTROL, AND ENCOURAGES EMPATHY FOR THE LESS FORTUNATE.

CHARITY AND COMMUNITY

GIVING ZAKAT PURIFIES WEALTH AND SUPPORTS SOCIAL WELFARE. BEYOND ZAKAT, VOLUNTARY CHARITY (SADAQAH) IS ENCOURAGED TO ASSIST THOSE IN NEED. THESE CHARITABLE ACTS REINFORCE SOCIAL JUSTICE AND COMMUNAL RESPONSIBILITY WITHIN ISLAM.

BRANCHES AND DENOMINATIONS IN ISLAM

ISLAM IS NOT MONOLITHIC; IT COMPRISES VARIOUS BRANCHES AND SCHOOLS OF THOUGHT THAT DIFFER IN THEOLOGY, LAW, AND PRACTICE. THE TWO LARGEST DENOMINATIONS ARE SUNNI AND SHIA ISLAM, WHICH HAVE HISTORICAL AND DOCTRINAL DISTINCTIONS. UNDERSTANDING THESE DIFFERENCES IS ESSENTIAL FOR A COMPREHENSIVE GRASP OF ISLAMIC DIVERSITY.

SUNNI ISLAM

SUNNI MUSLIMS CONSTITUTE THE MAJORITY OF THE GLOBAL MUSLIM POPULATION. THEY EMPHASIZE THE CONSENSUS OF THE COMMUNITY (UMMAH) AND ACCEPT THE FIRST FOUR CALIPHS AS RIGHTFUL SUCCESSORS TO MUHAMMAD. SUNNI ISLAM INCLUDES VARIOUS LEGAL SCHOOLS LIKE HANAFI, MALIKI, SHAFI'I, AND HANBALI, WHICH INTERPRET ISLAMIC LAW (SHARIA) IN DIFFERENT WAYS.

SHIA ISLAM

SHIA MUSLIMS BELIEVE THAT LEADERSHIP SHOULD HAVE REMAINED WITHIN THE PROPHET'S FAMILY, SPECIFICALLY THROUGH HIS COUSIN AND SON-IN-LAW ALI. SHIA ISLAM HAS ITS OWN LEGAL TRADITIONS AND COMMEMORATES EVENTS SUCH AS ASHURA, MARKING THE MARTYRDOM OF IMAM HUSSEIN. THE LARGEST SHIA SECT IS THE TWELVERS, FOLLOWED BY OTHERS LIKE THE ISMAILIS AND ZAIDIS.

OTHER GROUPS

BESIDES SUNNI AND SHIA, OTHER GROUPS INCLUDE SUFISM, WHICH FOCUSES ON MYSTICISM AND SPIRITUAL EXPERIENCE, AND SMALLER SECTS WITH UNIQUE INTERPRETATIONS. THESE BRANCHES CONTRIBUTE TO THE RICH TAPESTRY OF ISLAMIC THOUGHT AND PRACTICE WORLDWIDE.

ISLAMIC LAW AND ETHICS

ISLAMIC LAW, OR SHARIA, ENCOMPASSES RELIGIOUS, MORAL, AND LEGAL PRINCIPLES DERIVED PRIMARILY FROM THE QURAN AND HADITH. SHARIA GOVERNS VARIOUS ASPECTS OF A MUSLIM'S LIFE, INCLUDING WORSHIP, FAMILY RELATIONS, BUSINESS TRANSACTIONS, AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE. IT AIMS TO PROMOTE JUSTICE, COMPASSION, AND SOCIAL WELFARE.

SOURCES OF ISLAMIC LAW

SHARIA IS BASED ON SEVERAL SOURCES:

- **THE QURAN:** THE PRIMARY TEXT PROVIDING DIVINE COMMANDMENTS.
- **HADITH:** TRADITIONS OF THE PROPHET ELABORATING ON QURANIC GUIDANCE.
- **IJTIHAD:** INDEPENDENT REASONING BY QUALIFIED SCHOLARS.
- **IJMA:** CONSENSUS AMONG SCHOLARS ON LEGAL ISSUES.

- **QIYAS:** ANALOGICAL REASONING TO EXTEND RULINGS.

ETHICAL PRINCIPLES IN ISLAM
