TOBIAS'S INTERACTIONS OFTEN PROVIDE A COUNTERPOINT TO AGNES'S INTENSITY, HIGHLIGHTING DIFFERENT COPING MECHANISMS IN THE FACE OF FEAR AND UNCERTAINTY.

HARRY AND EDNA

HARRY AND EDNA SERVE AS CATALYSTS IN THE PLAY, THEIR UNEXPECTED ARRIVAL BRINGING HIDDEN FEARS TO THE SURFACE.
