UNDERSTANDING THE HARLEM RENAISSANCE

THE HARLEM RENAISSANCE WAS A CULTURAL MOVEMENT THAT EMERGED IN THE EARLY 20TH CENTURY, PRIMARILY CENTERED IN HARLEM, NEW YORK CITY. IT REPRESENTED A FLOURISHING OF AFRICAN AMERICAN ART, LITERATURE, MUSIC, AND INTELLECTUAL THOUGHT. THIS PERIOD WAS CHARACTERIZED BY A COLLECTIVE EFFORT TO REDEFINE AFRICAN AMERICAN IDENTITY AND CHALLENGE PREVAILING RACIAL STEREOTYPES. UNDERSTANDING THIS HISTORICAL CONTEXT IS ESSENTIAL WHEN USING HARLEM RENAISSANCE WORKSHEETS, AS IT GROUNDS THE LEARNING EXPERIENCE IN THE SOCIAL AND POLITICAL REALITIES OF THE TIME. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

SIGNIFICANCE IN AMERICAN CULTURE
