ORIGINS AND ESTABLISHMENT OF THE HARRIS COUNTY JUDGE

THE CREATION OF COUNTY COURTS IN TEXAS

HOWEVER, THE OFFICE RETAINS SOME STATUTORY JUDICIAL FUNCTIONS, SUCH AS PRESIDING OVER COMMISSIONERS' COURT MEETINGS AND CERTAIN PROBATE MATTERS.

EXPANSION INTO EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP

AS HARRIS COUNTY GREW INTO A MAJOR METROPOLITAN AREA, THE JUDGE'S ROLE EXPANDED TO INCLUDE SIGNIFICANT EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONS.
