REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

WHITE-TAILED DEER

WHITE-TAILED DEER HUNTING IS ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR ACTIVITIES IN INDIANA. THE STATE PROVIDES MULTIPLE HUNTING SEASONS, INCLUDING ARCHERY, MUZZLELOADER, AND FIREARMS. WILD TURKEY

WATERFOWL AND SMALL GAME

SMALL GAME SPECIES SUCH AS SQUIRRELS, RABBITS, AND RACCOONS ALSO PROVIDE HUNTING OPPORTUNITIES WITH DESIGNATED SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS.

TRAPPING LAWS AND PERMITS

TRAPPING TOOLS
