OVERVIEW OF LAW ENFORCEMENT

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE

POLICE OFFICERS

JUDGES AND COURT PERSONNEL

JUDGES OVERSEE COURT PROCEEDINGS, MAKE RULINGS ON LEGAL MATTERS, AND ENSURE TRIALS ARE CONDUCTED FAIRLY. COURT PERSONNEL, INCLUDING CLERKS AND BAILIFFS, SUPPORT THE JUDICIAL PROCESS BY MANAGING CASE DOCUMENTATION AND COURTROOM SECURITY.

CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS AND REHABILITATION SPECIALISTS

CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS MAINTAIN SECURITY AND ORDER WITHIN DETENTION FACILITIES, WHILE REHABILITATION SPECIALISTS FOCUS ON PROGRAMS AIMED AT REDUCING RECIDIVISM THROUGH EDUCATION, COUNSELING, AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT.

PROCESSES AND PROCEDURES IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE
