EARLY LIFE AND POLITICAL CAREER

MILITARY SERVICE

MONROE'S TWO TERMS IN OFFICE WERE MARKED BY SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENTS THAT HELPED SHAPE THE NATION'S FUTURE TRAJECTORY.

ELECTION AND POLITICAL CONTEXT

MONROE WAS ELECTED PRESIDENT IN 1816 AND RE-ELECTED IN 1820, RUNNING VIRTUALLY UNOPPOSED DURING HIS SECOND TERM. THE MONROE DOCTRINE

THE MONROE DOCTRINE, ARTICULATED IN 1823 DURING MONROE'S PRESIDENCY, STANDS AS ONE OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT POLICIES IN AMERICAN HISTORY. IT DECLARED THAT THE WESTERN HEMISPHERE WAS NO LONGER OPEN TO EUROPEAN COLONIZATION AND THAT ANY ATTEMPTS BY EUROPEAN POWERS TO INTERFERE IN THE AFFAIRS OF NATIONS IN THE AMERICAS WOULD BE CONSIDERED HOSTILE ACTS AGAINST THE UNITED STATES. THIS POLICY ASSERTED U.S. INFLUENCE IN THE REGION AND ESTABLISHED A FOUNDATION FOR AMERICAN FOREIGN POLICY IN THE DECADES THAT FOLLOWED.

ORIGINS AND CONTEXT

THE MONROE DOCTRINE AROSE IN RESPONSE TO CONCERNS ABOUT EUROPEAN POWERS REASSERTING CONTROL OVER FORMER COLONIES IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN. AT THE TIME, MANY LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES WERE GAINING INDEPENDENCE FROM SPAIN AND PORTUGAL, AND THE U.S. SOUGHT TO PREVENT EUROPEAN INTERVENTION THAT COULD THREATEN THE STABILITY OF THE HEMISPHERE.

DOMESTIC POLICIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS

MONROE'S ADMINISTRATION WAS MARKED BY A SERIES OF DOMESTIC POLICIES THAT CONTRIBUTED TO THE GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE UNITED STATES.
