BACKGROUND OF JAMES TISSOT

RESEARCH AND PREPARATION

THIS TECHNIQUE CONTRASTED WITH THE HEAVIER OIL PAINTINGS TYPICAL OF RELIGIOUS ART AT THE TIME.
