DISTINCTIVE LANGUAGE AND DICTION

UNRELIABLE NARRATORS

OFTEN, SALINGER'S NARRATORS CAN BE CONSIDERED UNRELIABLE, AS THEIR PERCEPTIONS AND JUDGMENTS MAY BE BIASED OR INCOMPLETE. THIS NARRATIVE CHOICE INVITES READERS TO QUESTION THE PRESENTED REALITY AND ENGAGE CRITICALLY WITH THE TEXT.

LIMITED OMNISCIENT VIEWPOINTS

IN SOME STORIES, SALINGER EMPLOYS A LIMITED THIRD-PERSON PERSPECTIVE THAT CLOSELY FOLLOWS THE CONSCIOUSNESS OF ONE CHARACTER. THIS TECHNIQUE BALANCES NARRATIVE OBJECTIVITY WITH PSYCHOLOGICAL DEPTH, ALLOWING SUBTLE

EXPLORATION OF CHARACTER MOTIVATIONS AND INNER CONFLICTS.

THEMES AND MOTIFS IN SALINGER'S WORK
