BENEFITS OF USING JENGA QUESTIONS FOR STUDENTS

4. LIST THREE BRANCHES OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT.
5. DESCRIBE THE WATER CYCLE STAGES.

ADVANCED LEVEL QUESTIONS

ADVANCED QUESTIONS CHALLENGE STUDENTS TO ANALYZE, SYNTHESIZE, AND EVALUATE INFORMATION CRITICALLY.

1. DISCUSS THE IMPACT OF THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION ON URBANIZATION.
2. CALCULATE THE AREA OF A TRIANGLE WITH A BASE OF 10 CM AND HEIGHT OF 5 CM.
3. ANALYZE THE SYMBOLISM USED IN THE POEM "THE ROAD NOT TAKEN."
4. EXPLAIN THE PROCESS OF CELLULAR RESPIRATION AND ITS IMPORTANCE.
