DEATH WAS NEITHER FEARED NOR SEEN AS AN END BUT AS A GATEWAY TO AN ETERNAL LIFE THAT COULD BE BLISSFUL OR TORTUROUS DEPENDING ON ONE'S EARTHLY DEEDS AND RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE.

PREPARATION FOR THE JOURNEY

PREPARATION FOR THE JOURNEY TO THE AFTERLIFE ANCIENT EGYPT INVOLVED ELABORATE FUNERARY RITUALS AND TOMB CONSTRUCTION TO PROTECT AND SUSTAIN THE DECEASED IN THE NEXT WORLD. MUMMIFICATION PROCESS

MUMMIFICATION WAS A SOPHISTICATED EMBALMING TECHNIQUE DESIGNED TO PRESERVE THE BODY FOR ETERNITY. THE PROCESS INCLUDED REMOVING INTERNAL ORGANS, DRYING THE BODY WITH NATRON SALTS, AND WRAPPING IT IN LINEN BANDAGES. FUNERARY GOODS AND TOMB OFFERINGS

INCLUDED IN THE TOMB WERE ITEMS THOUGHT NECESSARY FOR A COMFORTABLE AFTERLIFE: FOOD, CLOTHING, JEWELRY, AND TOOLS. STATUES OF SERVANTS AND PETS WERE SOMETIMES INCLUDED TO PROVIDE COMPANIONSHIP, WHILE AMULETS OFFERED MAGICAL PROTECTION. THE FURNISHINGS AND GOODS REFLECTED THE SOCIAL STATUS OF THE DECEASED AND THEIR ANTICIPATED NEEDS IN THE AFTERLIFE.

THE ROLE OF GODS AND DIVINE PROTECTION

ANCIENT EGYPTIAN RELIGION ASSIGNED MANY GODS AND GODDESSES TO OVERSEE AND ASSIST THE SOUL ON ITS JOURNEY TO THE AFTERLIFE. THE BOOK OF THE DEAD AND MAGICAL SPELLS

THE WEIGHING OF THE HEART CEREMONY

IF HEAVIER, SYMBOLIZING SIN AND IMPURITY, THE SOUL WAS DEVoured BY AMMIT, A FEARSOME CREATURE PART LION, HIPPOPOTAMUS, AND CROCODILE.

SIGNIFICANCE OF THE HEART

THE HEART WAS CONSIDERED THE SEAT OF EMOTIONS, MEMORY, AND MORALITY. IT WAS THE KEY TO ETERNAL LIFE BECAUSE IT REVEALED THE TRUE CHARACTER OF THE INDIVIDUAL. EGYPTIANS BELIEVED THAT ONLY THOSE WHO ACHIEVED PURITY AND BALANCE COULD ENJOY THE REWARDS OF THE AFTERLIFE.
