JEAN PIAGET'S COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT THEORY

HIS THEORY IS STRUCTURED AROUND FOUR STAGES OF COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT, EACH CHARACTERIZED BY DIFFERENT WAYS OF PROCESSING INFORMATION AND UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD.

STAGES OF COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT

PIAGET IDENTIFIED THE FOLLOWING STAGES IN A CHILD'S COGNITIVE GROWTH:

- **SENSORIMOTOR STAGE (0-2 YEARS):** INFANTS LEARN THROUGH SENSORY EXPERIENCES AND MOTOR ACTIVITIES.
- **PREOPERATIONAL STAGE (2-7 YEARS):** CHILDREN DEVELOP LANGUAGE SKILLS AND SYMBOLIC THINKING BUT LACK LOGICAL REASONING.
- **CONCRETE OPERATIONAL STAGE (7-11 YEARS):** LOGICAL THINKING DEVELOPS, AND CHILDREN BEGIN TO UNDERSTAND

CONCRETE CONCEPTS.

- **FORMAL OPERATIONAL STAGE (12 YEARS AND UP):** ABSTRACT AND HYPOTHETICAL REASONING EMERGE.

THIS THEORY IS OFTEN INCLUDED IN KEY THEORIES OF CHILD DEVELOPMENT WORKSHEETS TO ASSESS COGNITIVE MILESTONES AND GUIDE INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGIES.

LEV VYGOTSKY'S SOCIOCULTURAL THEORY

SCAFFOLDING REFERS TO THE SUPPORT GIVEN BY ADULTS OR PEERS TO HELP THE CHILD PROGRESS WITHIN THIS ZONE. THESE CONCEPTS HIGHLIGHT THE IMPORTANCE OF SOCIAL INTERACTION IN LEARNING.

INCLUDING VYGOTSKY'S SOCIOCULTURAL THEORY IN A KEY THEORIES OF CHILD DEVELOPMENT WORKSHEET ENABLES EDUCATORS TO FOCUS ON COLLABORATIVE LEARNING AND APPROPRIATELY CHALLENGE CHILDREN'S ABILITIES.

KEY STAGES RELEVANT TO CHILDHOOD

THE STAGES MOST RELEVANT TO CHILD DEVELOPMENT INCLUDE:

- **TRUST VS. MISTRUST (INFANCY):** ESTABLISHING TRUST BASED ON CAREGIVERS' RELIABILITY.
