OVERWHELMED BY EXCESSIVE DETAILS

LONG OR COMPLEX TEXTS MAY CONTAIN NUMEROUS DETAILS, MAKING IT CHALLENGING TO IDENTIFY WHICH ARE RELEVANT. PRIORITIZE INFORMATION THAT DIRECTLY RELATES TO THE MAIN IDEA AND DISREGARD TANGENTIAL OR ANECDOTAL CONTENT. USING OUTLINES OR GRAPHIC ORGANIZERS CAN ASSIST IN SORTING DETAILS EFFECTIVELY.
