ORIGINS AND HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

THE BROTHERS GRIMM LATER ADAPTED THE TALE IN THE 19TH CENTURY, MODIFYING THE NARRATIVE TO INCLUDE A MORE POSITIVE RESOLUTION.

ORIGINS OF THE THREE LITTLE PIGS

THE THREE LITTLE PIGS STORY ALSO HAS A LONG ORAL TRADITION, WITH VERSIONS FOUND THROUGHOUT EUROPE. THE MOST FAMILIAR WRITTEN VERSION WAS PUBLISHED BY JOSEPH JACOBS IN THE LATE 19TH CENTURY. PLOT OF THE THREE LITTLE PIGS

IN THIS TALE, THREE PIGS BUILD HOUSES FROM DIFFERENT MATERIALS: STRAW, STICKS, AND BRICKS. A HUNGRY WOLF ATTEMPTS TO BLOW DOWN EACH PIG'S HOUSE TO CAPTURE THEM. THE FIRST TWO PIGS, WITH THEIR FLIMSY HOUSES, ARE EASILY DEFEATED, BUT THE THIRD PIG'S BRICK HOUSE WITHSTANDS THE WOLF'S EFFORTS. THE WOLF'S FAILURE HIGHLIGHTS THE BENEFITS OF CAREFUL PLANNING AND HARD WORK.

KEY CHARACTERS IN BOTH TALES

- **LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD:** A YOUNG GIRL SYMBOLIZING INNOCENCE AND NAIVETY.
