UNDERSTANDING LONG TERM EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE GOALS

SETTING LONG TERM GOALS HELPS CLINICIANS AND EDUCATORS FOCUS ON THE BROADER DEVELOPMENTAL MILESTONES AND ENSURES THAT THERAPY IS PURPOSEFUL AND ALIGNED WITH THE INDIVIDUAL'S COMMUNICATIVE NEEDS.

DEFINITION AND SCOPE

NARRATIVE AND DISCOURSE SKILLS

PRAGMATIC LANGUAGE USE

ASSESSMENT AND PROGRESS MONITORING

ASSESSMENT IS CRITICAL FOR IDENTIFYING BASELINE EXPRESSIVE LANGUAGE ABILITIES AND INFORMING LONG TERM GOAL DEVELOPMENT. REGULAR PROGRESS MONITORING ENSURES THAT INTERVENTION REMAINS EFFECTIVE AND RESPONSIVE TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S EVOLVING NEEDS.

ASSESSMENT TOOLS AND METHODS
