A FALSE START IS CALLED IF AN ATHLETE LEAVES EARLY, AND THE NFHS RULES GENERALLY IMPOSE IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION FOR THE OFFENDING ATHLETE. THIS STRICT POLICY IS A COMMON FOCUS ON THE EXAM.

LANE ASSIGNMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS

IN RACES WHERE LANES ARE ASSIGNED, SUCH AS THE 100M, 200M, AND 400M, ATHLETES MUST REMAIN WITHIN THEIR DESIGNATED LANES THROUGHOUT THE RACE. STEPPING OUT OF THE LANE CAN RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. THE EXAM OFTEN TESTS KNOWLEDGE ON LANE VIOLATIONS AND THE CONSEQUENCES OF SUCH INFRACTIONS.

RACE FINISH AND TIMING

HIGH JUMP AND POLE VAULT REGULATIONS
