ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NJ PROPERTY AND CASUALTY LICENSE EXAM

BEFORE TAKING THE NJ PROPERTY AND CASUALTY LICENSE EXAM, CANDIDATES MUST MEET SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA SET BY THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND INSURANCE. THESE REQUIREMENTS ENSURE THAT APPLICANTS ARE PREPARED AND QUALIFIED TO ENTER THE INSURANCE PROFESSION. AGE AND RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION

NEW JERSEY MANDATES COMPLETION OF A PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION COURSE BEFORE SITTING FOR THE EXAM. THIS COURSE PROVIDES FOUNDATIONAL KNOWLEDGE ABOUT INSURANCE PRINCIPLES, STATE REGULATIONS, AND ETHICAL CONSIDERATIONS SPECIFIC TO PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE. THROUGH AUTHORIZED VENDORS AND MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO FINAL LICENSE APPROVAL.
