BIOGRAPHY OF OTTO RANK

OTTO RANK'S THEORIES ON ART AND CREATIVITY

RANK BELIEVED THAT ART IS A VITAL COMPONENT OF THE INDIVIDUATION PROCESS—THE JOURNEY TOWARD SELF-REALIZATION AND PSYCHOLOGICAL WHOLENESS. THROUGH ARTISTIC CREATION, INDIVIDUALS RECONCILE THEIR INNER TENSIONS AND ASSERT THEIR UNIQUE IDENTITY. THIS PROCESS IS BOTH THERAPEUTIC AND TRANSFORMATIVE, ALLOWING THE ARTIST TO CONFRONT EXISTENTIAL ANXIETIES AND ACHIEVE A SENSE OF MASTERY OVER THEIR UNCONSCIOUS IMPULSES.

CREATIVITY AND THE WILL
