SKELETAL SYSTEM OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS

THE SKELETAL SYSTEM FORMS THE STRUCTURAL FOUNDATION OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS, PROVIDING SUPPORT, PROTECTION, AND FACILITATING MOVEMENT.
