UNDERSTANDING PLACE-BASED EDUCATION ACCORDING TO DAVID SOBEL

PLACE-BASED EDUCATION, AS DEFINED BY DAVID SOBEL, IS AN INSTRUCTIONAL APPROACH THAT USES THE LOCAL COMMUNITY AND ENVIRONMENT AS THE PRIMARY CONTEXT FOR LEARNING. DEFINITION AND ORIGINS
