ADMINISTRATION AND SCORING OF PLS-5

TESTING PROCEDURES

AUDITORY COMPREHENSION SCALE

THIS SCALE ASSESSES A CHILD'S ABILITY TO UNDERSTAND SPOKEN LANGUAGE. IT EVALUATES SKILLS SUCH AS FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS, UNDERSTANDING VOCABULARY, AND GRASPING CONCEPTS CONVEYED THROUGH LANGUAGE. KEY SUBTESTS INCLUDE:

- VOCABULARY COMPREHENSION
- CONCEPTUAL UNDERSTANDING
- FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS

EXPRESSIVE COMMUNICATION SCALE

THE EXPRESSIVE COMMUNICATION SCALE MEASURES HOW WELL A CHILD CAN CONVEY THOUGHTS, IDEAS, AND NEEDS VERBALLY. IT FOCUSES ON VOCABULARY USE, SENTENCE STRUCTURE, AND PRAGMATIC LANGUAGE SKILLS. IMPORTANT SUBTESTS INCLUDE:

- VOCABULARY PRODUCTION
- SENTENCE IMITATION
- DESCRIPTIVE LANGUAGE

APPLICATIONS AND USES IN CLINICAL AND EDUCATIONAL SETTINGS
