THE TRANSITION FROM PAGAN SACRED VESSELS TO A CHRISTIAN HOLY RELIC WAS A GRADUAL PROCESS, BLENDING EXISTING SYMBOLISM WITH NEW THEOLOGICAL MEANING. HER DEMISE UNDERSCORES THE OFTEN-PERILOUS NATURE OF SUCH PURSUITS.

7. *PARSIFAL*: RICHARD WAGNER'S OPERA, INSPIRED BY WOLFRAM VON ESCHENBACH'S EPIC, PRESENTS A DEEPLY SPIRITUAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL INTERPRETATION OF THE GRAIL LEGEND.
