CONSENT AND COMMUNICATION WITH THE FAMILY ARE INTEGRAL TO THE PROCESS, ENSURING THAT THE TREATMENTS ALIGN WITH THEIR WISHES AND UNDERSTANDING.

ANATOMICAL ACCURACY IN RESTORATIVE ART

A DEEP UNDERSTANDING OF FACIAL ANATOMY IS THE BEDROCK OF EFFECTIVE RESTORATIVE ART WITHIN MORTUARY SCIENCE. COLOR THEORY AND SKIN TONE MATCHING

THIS METICULOUS ATTENTION TO COLOR ENSURES THAT THE FINAL PRESENTATION IS NOT ONLY ACCURATE BUT ALSO COMFORTING.

UNDERSTANDING TISSUE BEHAVIOR AND CHANGES

HAIR REPLACEMENT AND STYLING

THIS COMMITMENT TO TRUTHFULNESS ENSURES THAT FAMILIES CAN GRIEVE AND REMEMBER THEIR LOVED ONE BASED ON A GENUINE REPRESENTATION, FOSTERING TRUST AND RESPECT FOR THE MORTUARY SCIENCE PROFESSION.

INFORMED CONSENT AND FAMILY WISHES

OBTAINING INFORMED CONSENT AND RESPECTING THE WISHES OF THE DECEASED'S FAMILY IS A CRITICAL ETHICAL IMPERATIVE IN RESTORATIVE ART AND MORTUARY SCIENCE. RESPECT FOR THE DECEASED'S DIGNITY

ENSURING THAT THE DECEASED IS PRESENTED IN A PEACEFUL, NATURAL, AND DIGNIFIED MANNER IS THE ULTIMATE TESTAMENT TO THE COMPASSIONATE VALUES THAT UNDERPIN THE PRACTICE OF MORTUARY SCIENCE.
