ACT IV: DESPERATE MEASURES AND ILL-FATED PLANS

THE DISCOVERY OF THE LOVERS' BODIES BY THE WATCHMEN AND THE SUBSEQUENT EXPLANATIONS BY FRIAR LAURENCE AND OTHERS FINALLY BRING THE FEUDING FAMILIES TO AN END, UNITED IN THEIR SHARED SORROW.

KEY CHARACTERS IN THE ROMEO AND JULIET FULL SCRIPT
