IDENTIFYING YOUR IDEAL READER

PREFER CONCRETE AND SPECIFIC NOUNS AND VERBS OVER ABSTRACT OR VAGUE ONES. SHOW, DON'T JUST TELL, YOUR READER WHAT YOU MEAN.

WHAT'S A HELPFUL RULE OF THUMB FOR EDITING YOUR OWN WORK?

READ YOUR WORK ALOUD. THIS HELPS YOU CATCH AWKWARD PHRASING, REPETITIVE SENTENCES, AND GRAMMATICAL ERRORS YOU MIGHT OTHERWISE MISS.

WHAT'S A RULE OF THUMB FOR USING ADVERBS AND ADJECTIVES?

USE THEM SPARINGLY. STRONG VERBS AND NOUNS OFTEN DON'T NEED MODIFIERS. IF YOU FIND YOURSELF OVERUSING ADVERBS, CONSIDER IF A STRONGER VERB COULD ACHIEVE THE SAME EFFECT.

WHAT'S A CRUCIAL RULE OF THUMB FOR UNDERSTANDING YOUR AUDIENCE?

KNOW WHO YOU'RE WRITING FOR. TAILOR YOUR LANGUAGE, TONE, AND THE LEVEL OF DETAIL TO THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND INTERESTS TO ENSURE YOUR MESSAGE RESONATES.
