SHORT FOLKTALES OF EUROPE

WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF 'TRICKSTER' FIGURES IN GLOBAL FOLKTALES?

TRADITIONALLY, SHORT FOLKTALES WERE PRIMARILY PASSED DOWN ORALLY, THROUGH STORYTELLING WITHIN FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES. THIS ORAL TRADITION ALLOWED FOR VARIATIONS AND ADAPTATIONS, ENSURING THE STORIES REMAINED RELEVANT TO CHANGING TIMES.

WHAT ROLE DO SUPERNATURAL OR MAGICAL ELEMENTS PLAY IN SHORT FOLKTALES?
