GROUP DYNAMICS

THIS SECTION LOOKS AT THE BEHAVIOR OF INDIVIDUALS WITHIN GROUPS. IT COVERS TOPICS SUCH AS SOCIAL FACILITATION, SOCIAL LOAFING, GROUP POLARIZATION, GROUPTHINK, LEADERSHIP STYLES, AND INTERGROUP RELATIONS. PROSOCIAL BEHAVIOR, CONVERSELY, EXPLORES ALTRUISM, THE BYSTANDER EFFECT, AND THE FACTORS THAT ENCOURAGE HELPING BEHAVIOR.

PREJUDICE AND DISCRIMINATION

THIS VITAL TOPIC INVESTIGATES THE ORIGINS AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIORS TOWARDS SOCIAL GROUPS.
