FOR INSTANCE, FOR THE WORD "CAT," A LEARNER WOULD SOUND OUT /c/ /a/ /t/, AND THEN WRITE 'c', 'a', 't' IN THE

CORRESPONDING BOXES. MODELING THIS PROCESS, PROVIDING IMMEDIATE FEEDBACK, AND GRADUALLY INCREASING THE COMPLEXITY OF WORDS ARE CRUCIAL FOR SUCCESS. REGULARLY REVIEWING PREVIOUSLY MAPPED WORDS CAN ALSO REINFORCE LEARNING AND BUILD RETENTION.

INITIAL SOUND INTRODUCTION

WHEN FIRST INTRODUCING A SOUND, FOCUS ON ONE GRAPHEME AT A TIME. FOR EXAMPLE, WHEN TEACHING THE SOUND /s/, PRESENT THE LETTER 'S' AND DEMONSTRATE ITS SOUND. THEN, USE A SIMPLE WORD LIKE "SUN" AND GUIDE THE STUDENT TO SAY THE SOUNDS /s/ /u/ /n/ AND MAP THEM TO 'S', 'U', 'N' ON THE PAPER.

SEGMENTING AND BLENDING PRACTICE

PRACTICE SEGMENTING AND BLENDING SOUNDS EXTENSIVELY. THIS INVOLVES BREAKING DOWN WORDS INTO THEIR INDIVIDUAL PHONEMES AND THEN BLENDING THOSE PHONEMES BACK TOGETHER TO FORM THE WORD. SOUND SPELLING MAPPING PAPER PROVIDES A TANGIBLE WAY TO VISUALIZE THIS PROCESS.

THE KEY IS TO MAINTAIN A CLEAR AND CONSISTENT LAYOUT THAT VISUALLY SUPPORTS THE SOUND-TO-SPELLING MAPPING PROCESS. THIS FLEXIBILITY ALLOWS FOR CUSTOMIZATION BASED ON THE SPECIFIC PHONICS SKILLS BEING TARGETED AND THE INDIVIDUAL LEARNER'S PROGRESS.
