JOHN PROCTOR

JOHN PROCTOR IS A FARMER WHO HARBORS GUILT OVER HIS AFFAIR WITH ABIGAIL. THOUGH NOT FULLY INTRODUCED IN ACT 1, HIS ROLE AS A VOICE OF REASON AND MORAL CONSCIENCE IS ESTABLISHED THROUGH DIALOGUE. HIS COMPLEX RELATIONSHIP WITH ABIGAIL FORESHADOWS CRITICAL CONFLICTS.
