THE DESCENT OF MAN CHARLES DARWIN REPRESENTS A PIVOTAL WORK IN THE HISTORY OF EVOLUTIONARY BIOLOGY AND ANTHROPOLOGY. 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HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF THE DESCENT OF MAN

DARWIN'S MOTIVATIONS FOR WRITING THE DESCENT OF MAN

SCIENTIFIC ENVIRONMENT IN THE 19TH CENTURY

THE SCIENTIFIC COMMUNITY OF THE 19TH CENTURY WAS ENGAGED IN DEBATES ABOUT GEOLOGY, PALEONTOLOGY, AND THE CLASSIFICATION OF SPECIES. SEXUAL SELECTION AS A DRIVING FORCE

SEXUAL SELECTION ALSO PROVIDED A FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING HUMAN DIFFERENCES IN BEHAVIOR AND PHYSICAL APPEARANCE BETWEEN MALES AND FEMALES.

EVOLUTION OF MENTAL AND MORAL FACULTIES

DARWIN EXTENDED HIS EVOLUTIONARY ANALYSIS TO HUMAN PSYCHOLOGY, INCLUDING INTELLIGENCE, EMOTIONS, AND MORALITY. HE PROPOSED THAT MENTAL FACULTIES EVOLVED GRADUALLY AND WERE SUBJECT TO NATURAL SELECTION. MORAL SENSIBILITIES, ACCORDING TO DARWIN, AROSE FROM SOCIAL INSTINCTS THAT FAVORED COOPERATION AND ALTRUISM WITHIN GROUPS, ENHANCING SURVIVAL. THIS VIEW POSITIONED HUMAN ETHICS WITHIN A NATURALISTIC FRAMEWORK, CHALLENGING PHILOSOPHICAL AND THEOLOGICAL INTERPRETATIONS OF MORALITY.

SEXUAL SELECTION AND HUMAN EVOLUTION
