## ORIGINS OF CRIME JOURNALISM

UNTIL A MURDERER IS LEGALLY CONVICTED, JOURNALISTS MUST UPHOLD THE PRINCIPLE OF PRESUMPTION OF INNOCENCE. REPORTING SHOULD AVOID BIASED LANGUAGE OR PREMATURE CONCLUSIONS THAT MAY INFLUENCE PUBLIC OPINION OR JUDICIAL OUTCOMES.

## MANIPULATION AND SOURCE RELIABILITY

MURDERERS OR THEIR ASSOCIATES MAY ATTEMPT TO USE THE MEDIA TO MANIPULATE NARRATIVES OR GAIN NOTORIETY. JOURNALISTS MUST CRITICALLY ASSESS SOURCES AND AVOID BECOMING CONDUITS FOR MISINFORMATION OR PROPAGANDA.

## PSYCHOLOGICAL DYNAMICS BETWEEN JOURNALISTS AND MURDERERS

CONDUCTING INTERVIEWS WITH MURDERERS REQUIRES SKILLFUL QUESTIONING AND PSYCHOLOGICAL INSIGHT. JOURNALISTS MUST BALANCE EMPATHY AND SKEPTICISM, AIMING TO EXTRACT TRUTHFUL INFORMATION WITHOUT ENABLING MANIPULATION.

## NOTORIETY AND THE MEDIA SPOTLIGHT
