DIRECTION AND PRODUCTION

THE VIRGIN SUICIDES FULL FILM WAS DIRECTED BY SOFIA COPPOLA AND RELEASED IN 1999. IT MARKED COPPOLA'S FEATURE FILM DIRECTORIAL DEBUT AND WAS PRAISED FOR ITS FAITHFUL YET ARTISTICALLY DISTINCT ADAPTATION OF EUGENIDES' NOVEL. THE FILM'S PRODUCTION EMPHASIZED MOOD, ATMOSPHERE, AND VISUAL STORYTELLING, CAPTURING THE ETHEREAL QUALITY OF THE SOURCE MATERIAL.

CAST AND PERFORMANCES

THEMATIC EXPLORATION
