THIS PRECAUTION PREVENTS ACCIDENTAL MOVEMENT AND ALLOWS THE INSPECTOR TO FOCUS FULLY ON THE EVALUATION WITHOUT SAFETY CONCERNS. ENSURING THE ENVIRONMENT IS FREE OF OBSTRUCTIONS OR HAZARDS IS ALSO ESSENTIAL.

CORE COMPONENTS OF THE WEEKLY FORKLIFT INSPECTION CHECKLIST

FLUID LEVELS AND LEAKS

TIRE CONDITION AND PRESSURE

TIRES SHOULD BE EXAMINED FOR WEAR, CUTS, AND EMBEDDED DEBRIS. CORRECT TIRE PRESSURE MUST BE MAINTAINED ACCORDING TO MANUFACTURER GUIDELINES TO ENSURE STABILITY AND SAFE HANDLING. WORN OR DAMAGED TIRES INCREASE THE RISK OF ACCIDENTS AND SHOULD BE REPLACED PROMPTLY.

BATTERY AND ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

FOR ELECTRIC FORKLIFTS, BATTERY CONDITION, ELECTROLYTE LEVELS, AND CABLE CONNECTIONS REQUIRE INSPECTION. ANY CORROSION OR LOOSE CONNECTIONS MUST BE ADDRESSED. TESTING THE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM ENSURES RELIABLE STARTING AND OPERATION THROUGHOUT SHIFTS.

COMMON ISSUES IDENTIFIED DURING INSPECTIONS

BRAKE MALFUNCTIONS

BRAKE ISSUES SUCH AS REDUCED RESPONSIVENESS OR UNUSUAL NOISES CAN COMPROMISE OPERATOR CONTROL. REGULAR BRAKE CHECKS AND MAINTENANCE ENSURE THAT STOPPING POWER REMAINS RELIABLE UNDER ALL CONDITIONS.

ELECTRICAL FAILURES
