

WHAT IS THE DEUTERONOMIC HISTORY

WHAT IS THE DEUTERONOMIC HISTORY IS A QUESTION THAT DELVES INTO A SIGNIFICANT SCHOLARLY CONCEPT WITHIN BIBLICAL STUDIES, PARTICULARLY CONCERNING THE COMPOSITION AND INTERPRETATION OF CERTAIN OLD TESTAMENT BOOKS. 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ORIGINS AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE DEUTERONOMIC HISTORY

THIS PERSPECTIVE IS HEAVILY INFLUENCED BY THE THEOLOGY OF THE BOOK OF DEUTERONOMY, WHICH ITSELF EMPHASIZES COVENANTAL OBEDIENCE AND CENTRAL WORSHIP IN JERUSALEM. THE DEUTERONOMIC HISTORY IS THOUGHT TO HAVE BEEN COMPILED DURING THE BABYLONIAN EXILE IN THE 6TH CENTURY BCE, REFLECTING ON ISRAEL'S PAST TO EXPLAIN THE REASONS FOR THEIR CURRENT SUFFERING AND DISPLACEMENT.

THIS EDITORIAL WORK LIKELY AIMED TO PROVIDE A COHERENT INTERPRETATION OF ISRAEL'S HISTORY FROM THE CONQUEST OF CANAAN TO THE FALL OF THE KINGDOMS OF ISRAEL AND JUDAH. - **1 AND 2 KINGS:** DETAIL THE HISTORY OF THE ISRAELITE MONARCHY FROM SOLOMON THROUGH THE DIVISION INTO NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN KINGDOMS, CULMINATING IN THEIR RESPECTIVE EXILES.

SOME SCHOLARS EXTEND THE DEUTERONOMIC HISTORY TO INCLUDE PARTS OF DEUTERONOMY ITSELF, PARTICULARLY THE HISTORICAL PROLOGUE SECTIONS, AS THEY FORM THE THEOLOGICAL FOUNDATION FOR THE SUBSEQUENT NARRATIVE. THE UNITY OF THESE BOOKS UNDER THE DEUTERONOMIC HISTORY HIGHLIGHTS THEIR SHARED EDITORIAL STYLE, THEOLOGICAL FOCUS, AND NARRATIVE CONTINUITY.
