THE BOOK WAS PUBLISHED IN 2006 AND QUICKLY GAINED ATTENTION FOR ITS POWERFUL STORYTELLING AND HUMANITARIAN MESSAGE.

## ORIGIN OF THE TITLE

EVENTUALLY, VALENTINO WAS SELECTED FOR RESETTLEMENT IN THE UNITED STATES, WHERE HE FACED NEW CHALLENGES ADAPTING TO AMERICAN CULTURE WHILE COPING WITH TRAUMA AND LOSS.
