ANTIPHOLUS OF EPHEBUS'S WIFE, ADRIANA, BECOMES SUSPICIOUS OF HER HUSBAND'S STRANGE BEHAVIOR, WHILE MERCHANTS AND TOWNSFOLK ARE BAFFLED BY THE CONTRADICTORY ACTIONS OF THE TWINS. EVENTUALLY, THE PLAY RESOLVES WITH THE DISCOVERY OF THE TWINS' TRUE IDENTITIES AND A JOYFUL FAMILY REUNION.

## Main Characters and Their Roles

SERVING AS THE COMIC RELIEF, THE TWIN SERVANTS SHARE THEIR MASTERS' NAMES AND PHYSICAL APPEARANCES. THEIR WITTY BANTER AND SLAPSTICK SITUATIONS ENHANCE THE HUMOR THROUGHOUT THE PLAY.

### ADRIANA AND OTHER SUPPORTING CHARACTERS

ADRIANA, THE WIFE OF ANTIPHOLUS OF EPHEBUS, PLAYS A CRUCIAL ROLE IN THE CONFUSION AS SHE REACTS TO HER HUSBAND'S SEEMINGLY ERRATIC BEHAVIOR. OTHER CHARACTERS, SUCH AS THE MERCHANT ANGELO AND THE COURTESAN LUCE, CONTRIBUTE TO SUBPLOTS AND THE TANGLED WEB OF MISUNDERSTANDINGS.

## THEMES AND MOTIFS IN THE COMEDY OF ERRORS
