ITS CYLINDRICAL SHAFT AND EXPANDED ENDS CONTAIN SEVERAL IMPORTANT ANATOMICAL LANDMARKS THAT ARE FREQUENTLY TESTED IN ANATOMY QUIZZES. KEY ANATOMICAL LANDMARKS OF THE HUMERUS

PROXIMAL END LANDMARKS

- **HEAD OF THE HUMERUS:** A SMOOTH, HEMISPHERICAL SURFACE THAT ARTICULATES WITH THE GLENOID CAVITY OF THE SCAPULA.
- **ANATOMICAL NECK:** A SLIGHT CONSTRICTION IMMEDIATELY BELOW THE HEAD, MARKING THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE HEAD AND TUBERCLES.
- **GREATER TUBERCLE:** A LARGE LATERAL PROMINENCE FOR MUSCLE ATTACHMENT.
- **LESSER TUBERCLE:** A SMALLER ANTERIOR PROJECTION ALSO SERVING AS A MUSCLE ATTACHMENT SITE.
- **INTERTUBERCULAR GROOVE (BICIPITAL GROOVE):** A GROOVE BETWEEN THE TUBERCLES THAT GUIDES THE TENDON OF

THE LONG HEAD OF THE BICEPS BRACHII MUSCLE.

SHAFT AND DISTAL END LANDMARKS

THE SHAFT AND DISTAL END OF THE HUMERUS ALSO EXHIBIT SEVERAL DISTINCT FEATURES:

- **DELTOID TUBEROSITY:** A ROUGHENED AREA ON THE LATERAL SHAFT WHERE THE DELTOID MUSCLE ATTACHES.
- **MEDIAL AND LATERAL EPICONDYLES:** BONY PROMINENCES ON THE DISTAL END FOR LIGAMENT AND MUSCLE ATTACHMENT.
- **CAPITULUM:** A ROUNDED KNOB ON THE LATERAL DISTAL END THAT ARTICULATES WITH THE RADIUS.
- **TROCHLEA:** A SPOOL-SHAPED STRUCTURE MEDIALLY LOCATED, ARTICULATING WITH THE ULNA.
- **OLECRANON FOSSA:** A DEEP POSTERIOR DEPRESSION ACCOMMODATING THE OLECRANON OF THE ULNA DURING ELBOW EXTENSION.
- **CORONOID FOSSA:** A SHALLOW ANTERIOR DEPRESSION THAT RECEIVES THE CORONOID PROCESS OF THE ULNA DURING ELBOW FLEXION.
- **RADIAL FOSSA:** A SMALL DEPRESSION ABOVE THE CAPITULUM THAT ACCOMMODATES THE HEAD OF THE RADIUS WHEN THE ELBOW IS FLEXED.

ARTICULATIONS AND JOINT CONNECTIONS

THE HUMERUS PARTICIPATES IN TWO MAJOR JOINTS OF THE UPPER LIMB: THE SHOULDER JOINT AND THE ELBOW JOINT. UNDERSTANDING THESE ARTICULATIONS IS CRUCIAL FOR COMPREHENDING THE BONE'S ROLE IN UPPER LIMB MOBILITY AND STABILITY.

SHOULDER JOINT ARTICULATION

THE PROXIMAL HEAD OF THE HUMERUS ARTICULATES WITH THE GLENOID CAVITY OF THE SCAPULA, FORMING THE GLENOHUMERAL JOINT. THIS BALL-AND-SOCKET JOINT PROVIDES A WIDE RANGE OF MOTION INCLUDING FLEXION, EXTENSION, ABDUCTION, ADDUCTION, ROTATION, AND CIRCUMDUCTION. THE STABILITY OF THIS JOINT IS REINFORCED BY SURROUNDING MUSCLES, LIGAMENTS, AND THE LABRUM.

ELBOW JOINT ARTICULATIONS

THE DISTAL HUMERUS FORMS PART OF THE ELBOW JOINT BY ARTICULATING WITH TWO BONES:

- **RADIUS:** THE CAPITULUM OF THE HUMERUS ARTICULATES WITH THE HEAD OF THE RADIUS, ALLOWING FOR FLEXION/EXTENSION AND FOREARM ROTATION.
- **ULNA:** THE TROCHLEA OF THE HUMERUS ARTICULATES WITH THE TROCHLEAR NOTCH OF THE ULNA, PRIMARILY ENABLING FLEXION AND EXTENSION.

THESE ARTICULATIONS ENABLE PRECISE AND VERSATILE MOVEMENTS ESSENTIAL FOR DAILY ACTIVITIES AND COMPLEX MOTOR TASKS.

MUSCULAR ATTACHMENTS ON THE HUMERUS

THE HUMERUS SERVES AS AN ATTACHMENT SITE FOR NUMEROUS MUSCLES INVOLVED IN SHOULDER AND ARM MOVEMENTS. FAMILIARITY WITH THESE ATTACHMENTS IS IMPORTANT WHEN STUDYING THE ANATOMY OF THE HUMERUS QUIZ AND IN CLINICAL CONTEXTS SUCH AS INJURY ASSESSMENT.

MUSCLES ATTACHING TO THE PROXIMAL HUMERUS

- **SUPRASPINATUS:** INSERTS ON THE SUPERIOR FACET OF THE GREATER TUBERCLE.
- **INFRASPINATUS:** ATTACHES TO THE MIDDLE FACET OF THE GREATER TUBERCLE.
- **TERES MINOR:** CONNECTS TO THE INFERIOR FACET OF THE GREATER TUBERCLE.
- **SUBSCAPULARIS:** INSERTS ON THE LESSER TUBERCLE.

MUSCLES ATTACHING ALONG THE SHAFT AND DISTAL HUMERUS

SEVERAL MUSCLES ATTACH TO THE SHAFT AND DISTAL REGIONS OF THE HUMERUS, INCLUDING:

- **DELTOID:** ATTACHES AT THE DELTOID TUBEROSITY, RESPONSIBLE FOR ARM ABDUCTION.
- **BRACHIALIS:** ORIGINATES FROM THE ANTERIOR DISTAL HUMERUS AND ACTS AS A MAJOR ELBOW FLEXOR.
- **BRACHIORADIALIS:** ORIGINATES NEAR THE LATERAL SUPRACONDYLAR RIDGE OF THE HUMERUS.
- **PRONATOR TERES AND TRICEPS BRACHII:** ATTACH TO VARIOUS EPICONDYLES AND RIDGES FOR FLEXION AND EXTENSION MOVEMENTS.
